2019 YEAR 6 SCHOOL JOURNEY

Following the success of our previous trips we would like to invite you to an information meeting about our 2018 Year 6 residential trip on **Tuesday 16 October at 9am in the hall**. We will be able to give you more information and the estimated cost of the trip at this time.

In 2018, the venue once again will be Osmington Bay in Dorset. The Centre is run by PGL who are a specialist company running courses and activities for primary aged children and the course will be tailored to suit our needs.

The children will take part in the multi-activity course which includes a range of activities e.g. Abseiling, Climbing, Sailing and Quad Biking. All the activities are fully supervised with trained instructors who have specialist qualifications where appropriate. PGL is registered with the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority (AALA) and the Centre provides all specialist equipment. All PGL centres have been awarded the Learning Outside the Classroom Quality Badge. The aim of the trip is to encourage team building and to develop the children's independence.

The children will be accommodated in comfortable 4 bedded chalets each with en-suite bathrooms and central heating. All accompanying staff chalets are adjacent to the children's rooms. We will be travelling to and from Osmington Bay by coach.

Residential trips organised by the school are an optional, but invaluable part of our curriculum. Children benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that they will find this trip both worthwhile and enjoyable. I do hope that your child will be able to take part.

Children who do not participate in the School Journey will attend school as normal.
